- 1 two pocket folder
- 1 spiral notebook-wide ruled
- 1 three ring binder
- 3 dozen #2 pencils
- 1 set of colored pencils (10 or 12 colors)
- 1 set of colored markers (fine point)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 twelve-inch ruler with inches and centimeters
- 1 package of wide-ruled lined notebook paper (approx 200 sheets)
- 1 zippered 3-ring Trapper Keeper (binder for homework)
- 1 small supply box to help you keep your desk organized

Please keep the dimensions of our cubbies in mind when deciding on a backpack: 9”x 9”x 32”. No hard backed back packs.

**Reusable water bottle (suggested/encouraged)

- 1 two pocket folder (red) for Spanish
- 1 10x8in subject notebook for Spanish
