



## LOWER AND MIDDLE SCHOOL EXTENDED DAY- McCarthy Campus

### Program

RHSM offers an Extended Day Program for students in Grades 1 through 8; *we offer a separate program, with its own registration form for our Beginning School students.* The Lower/Middle School program provides an extended day of enriching and fun experiences from 3:15 P.M. to 6:00 P.M. each regular school day. Students choose from a wide variety of classes or enjoy after school time with friends. Our afternoon program begins at the close of the regular school day. Lower School students check in with Extended Day staff at the dining hall computer and receive snack. Middle School students take the shuttle to the McCarthy campus where they check-in at the dining hall computer and receive snack as well. After students have been checked in, brief announcements are given. When students are dismissed from announcements, they either attend enrichment classes or remain in our general Games and Activities program. Parent or authorized adult must check out their child on the computer before leaving campus. Our program ends at 6:00 P.M.

### Registration

COMPLETE THE FORM AND MAIL IT TO US (720 Guardsman Way, Salt Lake City, UT 84108) OR BRING IT TO THE EXTENDED OFFICE LOCATED IN THE DINING HALL. Registration forms for enrichment classes will not be accepted after September 29, 2008; forms for the general program can be turned in at any time. *Parents will be notified only if their child does NOT get into a specified class.* Please note the starting and ending dates of specific classes as stated in the following pages. A registration form must be filled out **each trimester** in order to be enrolled in the program.

### Cost

The cost for the Lower School Extended Day Program is \$7.35 per hour for students in the general program, study hall, or computer class. For students who enroll in enrichment classes or lessons, the fee is \$5.60 per hour *plus extra fees as indicated.* The entire cost of the enrichment class will be charged if a student drops out. There is no pro-rating. Parents will be billed for the Lower School Extended Day Program on a monthly basis. The Lower School Extended Day Program is coded "Extended Day" on the billing statement. Special Class fees are billed at the beginning of each trimester.

### Attendance Policy

We will expect your child for the days specified on the registration form. Please notify us in advance if your child will not be in Extended for a certain day.

### Check-out Policy

Each day your child attends the program; **an authorized adult** must check him/her out on the computer. *We require a written note, email, or phone call to the Director, Stephanie Martin, (extension 2971), if someone other than an authorized adult is picking up your child.*

### Late Fee

A late pick-up fee of \$1.00 per minute will be charged after 6:00 P.M. to cover the staff that must stay until your arrival.

### Before School Program

We also offer the Before School Extended Day Program for all students who arrive on the McCarthy Campus from 7:30 A.M. to 8:20 A.M. Parents check in your child in the dining hall. At 8:00 A.M. Lower School students move outside. Please do not drop students off in the south parking lot before 8:00 A.M. The Before School Extended Day Program operates on a *drop-in basis only.* *There is no need to register for morning care.* The fee for Before School Extended Day is **\$7.35 per morning**, if your child arrives before 8:00 A.M. After 8:00 A.M., there is no charge.

## **REGULAR PROGRAM: \$7.35 per hour:**

### **Games and Activities**

Monday through Friday for grades 1-8. Our recreational program allows children a choice of activities: arts and crafts projects, indoor/outdoor games, free play, or reading. Students choose among these activities unless they are attending special classes.

### **Study Hall**

Monday through Thursday for grades 1-8. Our study hall monitor supervises students in a separate, quiet space where they may do homework, reading, or individual projects. Students who are not signed up for study hall may choose to go as needed. A minimum of six students is required in order to hold study hall. There is no internet access available.

### **BEGINNING OIL PAINTING: Kathryn Czarnecki / 3:30 – 4:30 / Thursday for Grades 4-8 / \$95.00 fee per trimester**

In this class students will explore the basics of oil painting on canvas. Young artists will learn perspective, composition, color mixing, acrylic under painting, and brush stroke techniques. All natural nontoxic turpenoid natural will be used in the place of turpentine – safe for artists of all ages. Subject matter will include still life studies and studies from portraits. All artwork created will be frame ready for the living room! (Minimum 6 students / Maximum 12 students). First- come, first -served.

### **CHESS: Javier Pinedo / 3:30-4:30 / Monday for Advanced Chess – Must have USCF ranking of 500 or higher at the time of registration. Instructor can/will verify rankings / Tuesday for Boys and Girls, Grades 3-5 / Wednesday for Girls Only, Grades 1-5 / Thursday for Boys and Girls, Grades 1-2 / \$115.00 fee per trimester**

Enjoy learning new chess strategies while having fun in a relaxed setting! Javier guides students into higher levels of chess play through chess games and critical thinking skills. Students also play with fellow students and are assisted by the computer to further develop chess skills in an atmosphere that is both recreational and educational. Any student who chooses may participate in scholastic tournaments. Registration is on a first- come, first -served basis. (Maximum 18 students each class).

Kids will have a fun time making a colorful paper mache piñata of a favorite animal shape. A piñata can be almost any color or shape you can imagine. Anyone can learn how to make a piñata. It's a great project! Traditionally, piñatas are the highlight of children's parties in Mexico. Students will bring their piñata creations home and fill them with candy and treats if they choose. In class we will make an extra piñata for our own party at the end of the fall session. We will hang the piñata and take a turn being blindfolded, then swing at the piñata in hopes of breaking it open for the special natural treats and gifts inside!
