Dear Sixth Grade Advisees and Parents,

Welcome to your first year at Rowland Hall-St. Mark's Middle School! This mailing includes a packet of materials, some to fill out and return to school, and many more to read. As your advisors, we will see you everyday; our advisory groups will meet first thing in the morning. During that time we will have announcements, discuss topics, complete activities, plan celebrations and community service activities, clean out lockers, and even conduct last-minute reviews for tests.
