Casting students who will sing and act in scenes that require groups of people on stage, as everyday working class and poor people. As such, you can expect a good amount of on stage time. Slots are open for students from each grade level – Both boys and girls are needed.

Les Miserable is entirely sung (there are no lines that are not sung) so the ability to sing, at least in a group, is a must.

Participation will require a commitment to frequent after school rehearsals. Those involved in sports activities will not be able to divide their time between the two. Rehearsals will run from 3:40 – 4:45 (almost every day) in the initial phase – then as the show moves towards integrating the Upper School cast with the Middle School members, additional time will be required.

Students must be able to balance academic responsibilities with a commitment to the show. Participation in the musical is undertaken for fun and the experience of being in a large-scale production – no arts credit is earned with participation.
